

What to Bring:

Bible, pencil, notebook, towel, washcloth, soap, comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, fitted twin sheet, sleeping bag, pillow, spending money for snack shop (\$10 is plenty for most), 2 pairs of shoes or sneakers, rain gear, sweater, jacket, sportswear, a “grubby outfit”, shorts, swimwear (1 piece), nice outfit for services—not fancy

Camper clothing should be modest. No short shorts, crop tops, etc.

Optional: flashlight, camera, sports equipment, fishing gear, musical instrument, archery gear
All items should be clearly labeled with camper’s name!

What NOT to Bring:

iPod/iPad/tablets, comics, magazines, electronic games, **cell phones**, laptops, cigarettes, vape pens or other drugs, matches/lighters, gum, weapons of any kind

If any of the above items are found in a camper’s possession they will be confiscated!
